Westville Police Service members responded to 98 calls for service in the month of April 2020. Of the calls for the month, 23 criminal investigations, 41 other provincial statutes, 5 municipal by-law enforcement, are 8 motor vehicle related and 21 are other calls to service.

During the month of April the Westville Police Service responded to 19 calls related to Covid-19. The calls were related to individuals not self-isolating on returning from out of province, businesses not complying with the social distancing rules and social distancing within the Town of Westville. 3 tickets have been issued and those matters are still before the courts.

On April 18, 2020 a complaint was made to the Westville Police Service regarding garbage being dumped on Campbell's Road. There were a couple of bags of garbage retrieved.
