

## **Westville Police Service**

Westville Police Service members responded to 125 calls for service in the month of June 2021. Of the calls for the month, 50 criminal investigations, 20 other provincial statutes, 11 municipal by-law enforcements, 25 are motor vehicles related and 19 are other calls to service.

During the month of June, the Westville Police Service had received several complaints from the public along with Westville Public Works Department of vandalism around Acadia Park. There were reports of damage committed to the gazebo along with damage to park benches and picnic tables. The Town of Westville's Neighbourhood Watch Program and the Westville Police Service installed 12 news signs around the Town of Westville indicating areas that are included in the Neighbourhood Watch Program. Bernie Murphy, Coordinator for the Neighbourhood Watch Program announced at the last meeting that the signs had been installed in areas that Chief Dunbar felt were good areas within the Town for the signs to be placed. The signs have shown positive response within the community generating more calls in certain areas regarding suspicious activity.
