Westville Police Service members responded to 135 calls for service in the month of December 2020. Of the calls for the month, 57 criminal investigations, 19 other provincial statutes, 5 municipal by-law enforcement, are 11 motor vehicles related and 43 are other calls to service.

On December 9 and 12 Westville Police Services received a complaint from a local business, Thrive Hair Studio of damage to their back door and window being smashed out on these two occasions. The damage to the building on both dates appears to have been committed after the business was closed. Westville Police Services spoke to surrounding business and neighbours with no additional information being disclosed.
