Westville Police Service members responded to 128 calls for service in the month of August 2020. Of the calls for the month, 32 criminal investigations, 20 other provincial statues, 5 municipal by-law enforcement, are 27 motor vehicles related and 44 are other calls to service.

In the month of August, the Westville Police Service have seen an increase in fraudulent calls to the residence of the Town of Westville. These phone scams usually come from someone who is calling with a foreign accent requesting private and personal information to be shared over the telephone. Westville Police Service would like to take this opportunity to inform the public that if you are not familiar with the person calling you on the phone you should never give any sort of personal, banking or private information. This phone scams usually originate from over seas and can change their phone numbers to appear is if they are calling from a local number.
