Westville Police Service members responded to 106 calls for service in the month of July 2019. Of the calls for the month, 28 criminal investigations, 24 other provincial statues, 6 municipal by-law enforcement, 14 are motor vehicle related and 34 are other calls to service.

Westville Police Service are pleased to announce that the July 1st celebrations in Westville went very well with very few minor occurrences resulting over the holiday.

The Westville Police Service is investigating a break and enters into the old Highland Consolidated School located on South Main Street. Between July 11 and the 12th there were two reported occurrences of entrance into the closed building. There is reported to be some damages to the inside as well as several windows and doors being busted open. The building is owned by the Town of Westville and there are many signs around the property stating No Trespassing. If anyone has any information into the damages caused at this sight you are asked to contact the Westville Police Services by phoning our dispatch at (902)396-4911 or drop by the department located at 2020 Queen Street.

There have been several reports of cars speeding throughout the Town of Westville in the month of July and August. The Westville Police Service has noted complaints from residence in the areas of Acadia Street and Temperance Street. In the past the station can also report receiving complaints about speeders in the area around Union and North Street as well. The speed limit within town limits is 50 km/h unless otherwise posted. If you have concerns with cars racing up and down your streets please call the Westville Police Services as soon as possible when seeing these racing vehicles.

On July 2, 2019 the Westville Public Works Department reported one of the Town's Canada Day banners had been stolen sometime the night before. Witnesses have reported seeing a small white car within that area before the banner went missing. If anyone has any information regarding the missing banner they are asked to contact the Westville Police Services.
