Westville Police Service members responded to 110 calls for service in the month of May 2020. Of the calls for the month, 32 criminal investigations, 17 other provincial statutes, 1 municipal by-law enforcement, 17 are motor vehicle related and 43 are other calls to service.

Westville Police Service has received multiple calls on vehicles speeding around the Acadia Avenue area as well in the neighbourhood around Campbell's Road. Residences have reported cars racing down these streets with loud mufflers. Reports of seeing these vehicles gathering at the parking lot located on North Main Street right across from Holy Name Church then leaving to race down Acadia Avenue. Westville Police have placed their Traffic Control Sign in these areas within the past few weeks to record the speeds. Westville Police have been given description of the vehicles and have been monitoring these areas regularly and are working hard to catch these vehicle drivers. Westville Police Service are asking the public at this time that if anyone sees any cars racing down their streets to call the police immediately at 902-396-4911.

In the month of May the Westville Police Service received several calls regarding illegal fires at different properties throughout the town. All calls were related to people having fires in fire pits in their backyards. All individuals involved were unaware at the time that there was a fire ban for the province of Nova Scotia in place.
