

## **Westville Police Service**

Westville Police Service members responded to 139 calls for service in the month of October 2020. Of the calls for the month, 54 criminal investigations, 14 other provincial statues, 4 municipal by-law enforcement, are 31 motor vehicles related and 36 are other calls to service.

In the month of October throughout the town of Westville there were several incidences reported where homes and vehicles had been hit by paint balls. Throughout Pictou County there have also been similar occurrence that have been reported as well. The damage has appeared to have taken place in the hours after midnight.
