Westville Police Service members responded to 82 calls for service in the month of December 2019. Of the calls for the month, 18 criminal investigations, 16 other provincial statutes, 5 municipal by-law enforcement, are 18 motor vehicle related and 25 are other calls to service.

The Parade of Lights was held on December 7, 2019 and as usual there were large crowds gathered across the Town of Westville enjoying the parade and fireworks. There were no major reports from that evening to report.

On December 10, 2019 there was a report of theft from the Cowan Street area of a Christmas Projector Light that had been stolen from the property between December 8 and December 10, 2019. There were several reports of people missing their Christmas Lights and or decorations in the Town of Westville. The Westville Police Service received several calls on December 19, 2019 of vehicles that had been entered. At this time the Westville Police Service would like to remind all residents to please keep their vehicle doors locked and or secured overnight and to remove all valuable items from their motor vehicle in the evenings. Throughout the month of December the Westville Police Services assisted the Westville Public Works Department with parking offences throughout the Town. As of December 1, 2019 until April 15, 2020 there is a Winter Parking Ban in affect for the Town of Westville. No vehicles are permitted to be parked on the street between those hours for possible snow removal and clean up.
